THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The funds held at The Toronto-Dominion Bank branch located at Unit 1 - 110 Brew Street, Port Moody, British Columbia, V3H0E4, Transit #9313 in Accounts 9313-7200698 ("CMN USD Account"), 9313-5006595 ("CNM CAD Account") and 9313-50077362 ("Easy Padala Account") to the benefit of CNM Communications Inc. and Easy Padala Inc. and the Proceeds thereof (collectively, the "Funds") are forfeited to Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of British Columbia pursuant to the provisions of the *Civil Forfeiture Act*, SBC 2005, c. 29 (the "*Act*").

2. Any person in possession of the Funds shall, upon receiving notice of this order, cause the Funds to be paid to the Director as soon as practicable.
3. Upon receiving the Funds, the Director shall, as soon as practicable, pay the Funds in to the Civil Forfeiture account of the Consolidated Revenue Fund pursuant to s.26 of the *Act*.
4. The parties shall bear their own costs of this proceeding.
